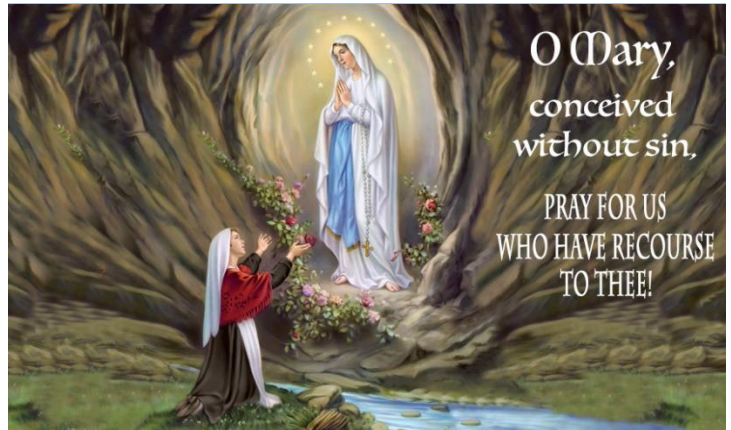

## The message of Lourdes

### 18<sup>th</sup> February 1858: EXTRAORDINARY WORDS

During the third apparition, on 18th February, the Virgin spoke for the first time: "what I have to say to you does not have to be written down". This means that Blessed Virgin Mary wished to communicate with Bernadette in a loving heart to heart way. From the very start, Bernadette was invited to open the depths of her heart to this message of Love.

Bernadette was overwhelmed by the second statement of the Virgin Mary: "Would you be so kind as to come here for fifteen days?" It is the first time that Bernadette was addressed in a formal way. She felt she was respected and loved, as a person in her own right. We are all worthy of respect in the eyes of God, because He loves each one of us.

The third statement of the Virgin was: "I do not promise to make you happy in this world but in the other." When Jesus, in the Gospel, invites us to discover the Kingdom of Heaven, He invites us to discover the "another world" within our world as it is. Wherever there is love, God is present.

### God is LOVE

In spite of her poverty, her illness and her lack of education, Bernadette was always deeply happy. That is the Kingdom of God, the world of true Love. During the first seven apparitions, Bernadette's face always radiated joy, happiness and light. However between the eight and twelfth apparitions, everything changed: Bernadette's face became harsh, sad, and sorrowful, and above all she performed incomprehensible gestures... She moved on her knees to the back of the Grotto. She kissed the dirty repulsive ground of the Grotto. She ate
