For Lent, read the Gospel, fast from Gossip



People should fast from gossiping and spreading hearsay as part of their Lenten journey, Pope Francis said.

"For Lent this year, I will not speak ill of others, I will not gossip and all of us can do this, everyone. This is a wonderful kind of fasting,"

"that won't make you feel hungry: fasting from spreading rumors and gossiping." And don't forget that it will also be helpful to read a verse from the Gospel every day." the Pope said Feb. 28 after praying the Sunday Angelus.

Valuable ways you can fast during Lent:

1. **Fast from noise:** Silence is rare gifts, pay attention, listen to the silence.
2. **Fast from Gossip:** fasting from gossip requires us to pay attention to our words and our motivation for what we share with others in conversation.
3. **Fast from hiding the truth:** that means you know the truth, but to please others you don't admit.
4. **Fast from your arrogance:** give someone a kind word, a smile.
5. **Fast from complaint:** do not pollute the attitudes of those around you, be a solution, rather than a contributor
6. **Fast from busyness:** slow down and make some time for the Lord, your family, loved ones.
7. **Fast from expectations:** without any expectations in return do good, help others.
8. **Fast from putting yourself first:** put the needs of others to the forefront, do a good deed for someone, helping a person, letting another driver in.
9. **Fast from asking God for what you want:** thank God for what you have, offer yourself to His will.
10. **Fast from being ungrateful:** be grateful that is not only physically healthy but mentally, emotionally and spiritually enriching, too.
11. **Read the Holy Bible:** open the Bible and read a verse everyday
